Kloof Country Club | 6 May 2022

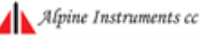

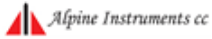

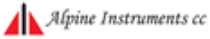


There has been a recent addition to the management team at ICA. Pictured here is proud Granddad Mark Calvert with Kai.
